A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to smoking; to prohibit smoking in certain
2 outdoor locations as prescribed; and to provide
3 exceptions.

4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Smoking is prohibited in or on any of the
2 following outdoor areas:

3 (1) The seating areas of outdoor sports arenas, stadiums,
4 amphitheaters, and other venues where members of the general public
5 assemble to witness athletic and entertainment events;

6 (2) Outdoor seating or serving areas of restaurants;

7 (3) Public transit stations, platforms, and shelters
8 under the authority of the state or its political subdivisions;

9 (4) School grounds, including parking lots, athletic
10 fields, playgrounds, tennis courts, and any other outdoor area
11 under the control of a public or private educational facility,
12 including inside any vehicle located on such school grounds; and

13 (5) The grounds of any public buildings owned, leased,
14 or operated by or under the control of the state or its political
15 subdivisions, including the grounds of a private residence of any
16 state employee any portion of which is open to the public. This
17 subdivision does not apply to:

18 (a) The Nebraska State Fairgrounds;

19 (b) Institutions administered by the Department of
20 Correctional Services in designated smoking areas on the grounds;
21 and

22 (c) Facilities of the Nebraska National Guard in
23 designated smoking areas on the grounds.
