- FOR AN ACT relating to the Tobacco Prevention and Control Cash

 Fund; to amend sections 71-5714 and 71-7608, Revised

 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008; to change the

 amount allocated to and distribution of the fund;

 to provide an operative date; to repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 71-5714, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 3 71-5714 The Tobacco Prevention and Control Cash
- 4 Fund is created. The fund shall be used for a comprehensive
- 5 statewide tobacco-related public health program administered by
- 6 the Department of Health and Human Services which includes, but
- 7 is not limited to (1) community programs to reduce tobacco use,
- 8 (2) chronic disease programs, (3) school programs, (4) statewide
- 9 programs, (5) enforcement, (6) counter marketing, (7) cessation
- 10 programs, (8) surveillance and evaluation, and (9) administration.
- 11 The department shall spend at least one-half of the amount
- 12 allocated annually to the fund pursuant to section 71-7608 on
- 13 <u>counter marketing.</u> Any money in the Tobacco Prevention and Control
- 14 Cash Fund available for investment shall be invested by the state
- 15 investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act
- 16 and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 71-7608, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 18 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 19 71-7608 The Nebraska Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund is
- 20 created. The fund shall include any settlement payments or other
- 21 revenue received by the State of Nebraska in connection with any
- 22 tobacco-related litigation to which the State of Nebraska is a
- 23 party. The Department of Health and Human Services shall remit such
- 24 revenue to the State Treasurer for credit to the fund, except that
- 25 of such revenue received on or after April 1, 2005, (1) two million
- 26 five hundred thousand dollars shall be credited for fiscal years
- 27 before FY2009-10 and (2) three twenty-one million dollars shall be

- 1 credited for FY2009-10 and subsequent fiscal years to the Tobacco
- 2 Prevention and Control Cash Fund. For FY2008-09 five hundred
- 3 thousand dollars shall be transferred from the Nebraska Tobacco
- 4 Settlement Trust Fund to the Tobacco Prevention and Control Cash
- 5 Fund. The State Treasurer shall make such transfer no later than
- 6 July 15, 2008. Beginning in July 2008 and each year thereafter,
- 7 on or before July 25, five hundred thousand dollars shall be
- 8 transferred from the Nebraska Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund to the
- 9 Stem Cell Research Cash Fund created under section 71-8805. Subject
- 10 to the terms and conditions of such litigation, money from the
- 11 Nebraska Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund shall be transferred to the
- 12 Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund as provided in section 71-7611.
- 13 Any money in the Nebraska Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund available
- 14 for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer
- 15 pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
- 16 State Funds Investment Act.
- 17 Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2009.
- 18 Sec. 4. Original sections 71-5714 and 71-7608, Revised
- 19 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008, are repealed.
- 20 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 21 when passed and approved according to law.
