- FOR AN ACT relating to tobacco; to amend sections 28-1418, 28-1419,
 28-1421, 28-1424, 28-1425, and 28-1427, Reissue Revised

 Statutes of Nebraska; to increase the age for tobacco
 use; to change penalties; to harmonize provisions; and to
 repeal the original sections.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 28-1418, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 28-1418 Whoever, being a minor Any person under the age
- 4 of eighteen nineteen years, shall smoke who smokes cigarettes or
- 5 cigars, or use uses tobacco in any form whatever, in this state,
- 6 shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor. Any minor so Such
- 7 person charged with the violation of this section may be free from
- 8 prosecution when he or she shall have furnished evidence for the
- 9 conviction of the person or persons selling or giving him or her
- 10 the cigarettes, cigars, or tobacco.
- 11 Sec. 2. Section 28-1419, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 12 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 13 28-1419 Whoever shall sell, give, or furnish, in any way,
- 14 any tobacco in any form whatever, or any cigarettes, or cigarette
- 15 paper, to any minor person under eighteen nineteen years of age,
- 16 shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor for each offense.
- 17 Sec. 3. Section 28-1421, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 18 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 19 28-1421 Licenses for the sale of cigars, tobacco,
- 20 cigarettes, and cigarette material to persons over the age
- 21 of eighteen nineteen years shall be issued to individuals,
- 22 partnerships, limited liability companies, and corporations by
- 23 the clerk or finance director of any city or village and by the
- 24 county clerk of any county upon application duly made as provided
- 25 in section 28-1422. The sale of cigarettes or cigarette materials
- 26 that contain perfumes or drugs in any form is prohibited and is
- 27 not licensed by the provisions of this section. Only cigarettes and

- 1 cigarette material containing pure white paper and pure tobacco
- 2 shall be licensed.
- 3 Sec. 4. Section 28-1424, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 4 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 5 28-1424 The license, provided for in sections 28-1421 and
- 6 28-1422 when issued, shall authorize the sale of cigars, tobacco,
- 7 cigarettes, and cigarette material by the licensee and employees,
- 8 to persons over the age of eighteen nineteen years, at the place of
- 9 business described in such license for the term therein authorized,
- 10 unless the same be license is forfeited as provided in section
- 11 28-1425.
- 12 Sec. 5. Section 28-1425, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 13 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 14 28-1425 Any licensee who shall sell, give, or furnish in
- 15 any way to any person under the age of eighteen nineteen years,
- 16 or who shall willingly allow to be taken from his or her place
- 17 of business by any person under the age of eighteen nineteen
- 18 years, any cigars, tobacco, cigarettes, or cigarette material,
- 19 shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. Any officer, director,
- 20 or manager having charge or control either separately or jointly
- 21 with others, of the business of any corporation which violates
- 22 the provisions of sections 28-1420 to 28-1429, if he or she have
- 23 knowledge of the same, shall be subject to the penalties provided
- 24 in this section. In addition to the penalties provided in this
- 25 section, such licensee shall be subject to the additional penalty
- 26 of a revocation and forfeiture of his, her, their, or its license,
- 27 at the discretion of the court before whom the complaint for

- 1 violation of said such sections may be heard. If such license be is
- 2 revoked and forfeited, all rights under such license shall at once
- 3 cease and terminate.
- 4 Sec. 6. Section 28-1427, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 5 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 6 28-1427 Any person under the age of eighteen nineteen
- 7 years who shall obtain cigars, tobacco, cigarettes, or cigarette
- 8 material from a licensee hereunder under sections 28-1420 to
- 9 <u>28-1429</u> by representing that he <u>or she</u> is of the age of eighteen
- 10 <u>nineteen</u> years or over, shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor.
- 11 Sec. 7. Original sections 28-1418, 28-1419, 28-1421,
- 12 28-1424, 28-1425, and 28-1427, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 13 Nebraska, are repealed.
