## A Proposed Bill

To make in-home daycares and vehicles used by that business smoke free all of the time. 1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Clean Indoor Air Act; to amend 2 section 71-5724, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 3 2008; to redefine a term; and to repeal the original 4 section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

CurrentProposed law:

71-5724. Place of employment, defined.

Place of employment means an indoor area under the control of a proprietor that an employee accesses as part of his or her employment without regard to whether the employee is present or work is occurring at any given time. The indoor area includes, but is not limited to, any work area, employee breakroom, restroom, conference room, meeting room, classroom, employee cafeteria, and hallway. A private residence is a place of employment when such residence is <u>licensed as a child care provider's location. A motor vehicle is a place of being</u> used as<u>employment at all times if it is used to transport children cared for by</u> a licensed child care provider.
